FLIGHT NOTES:

THE PASSENGER SCHEDULE IS NOW ENHANCED TO INCLUDE A COMPANY LOGO - The very tight economy of 2009 makes it more important than ever to leave a lasting impression on both passengers and clients. One way to do this is to use company branding to separate your trip-sheet from the others. Now you can optionally place a company Logo at the top-center of your Passenger Schedules. It can be the same logo that is used in the bidder, or it can be a different logo that takes advantage of the extra width available at the top of a trip-sheet. The logo is selected in the same screen where crew, client, purpose and tailnumber is selected. Once selected, all tripsheets will automatically include the same logo. However, logos can be deleted or alternated for certain clients or trips.

A "PROJECT-NUMBER" FOR A BID CAN MIX NUMERIC AND ALPHA CHARACTERS - The Bid number is automatically generated when you create a Bid, but you can also enter the more flexible Project Number which holds up to 10 characters and accepts alpha characters as well as numbers. The Project Number can be useful as a supplement to, or substitute for, the Bid Number. This is especially useful to those who must assess a different charge for each leg of a charter or to a part-91 flight. For instance a leg with certain clients may carry the number 1234B, while the next leg with a new set of passengers may carry the number 1234C. It is also possible to create a Project Number with only client initials. For instance, a set of legs can be designated as IBM1, IBM2 and IBM3. Even the title Project Number can be varied or modified.

FBO DETAILS SCREEN IN AIRPORT-AND-FBO SEARCH MODULE. A LARGE AMOUNT OF INFORMATION IS REPORTED FOR EACH FBO

THE AIRPORT-AND-FBO SEARCH MODULE HAS BEEN COMPLETELY RE-WRITTEN - The new Airport & FBO Search module has been rewritten completely with new screens that are easier to read and to operate. In addition, this new module will be compatible with the next version of MS Windows, when it is released. It is always a difficult thing to update a module while keeping everything familiar to current users. We think we have done that, and at the same time making buttons bigger and more informative. In addition, a number of screens can be expanded to take advantage of larger monitors. For convenience the new Airport-and-FBO Search module opens in a smaller window. The window can be enlarged, if needed.

NAVPAK NOW DISPLAYS AND PRINTS MORE THAN 1050 TAXI DIAGRAMMS - The International set of airport diagrams has now exceeded 1050 different illustrations. Coverage in North America represents the major proportion of the diagrams. However, virtually all international airports visited by corporate aviation are also represented in this set. In addition, there are a small set of military airports in the United States that have been included for specialized charter carriers.

Charter Payment Security (subject to the express approval of BJet): The Client shall provide proof of secure pre-payment of charter services per quote as follows (check one only):

(Check, if appropriate) By authorization of quote amount by BJet to Client's credit card. If used the Client authorizes BJet to charge the charter fees to the following Credit Card and to retain the credit card authorization for these costs for 30 days from credit card approval date: If used, photocopy of credit card, front & back, as well as a photocopy of the cardholder's approved photo-identification and the signature of the cardholder will be required.

(Check, if appropriate) By prepaid bank wire transfer to BJet for the quote amount (to be paid at least one business day before the scheduled departure time of the initial flight hereunder and the Client hereby authorizes BJet to apply such prepayment to the Client's account when charges are due hereunder, with any excess to be returned to the Client):

(Check, if appropriate) By corporate/company/personal check to be received by BJet within 10 days prior to departure of first leg of the Trip.

B. **CHARTER SERVICES:** So long as the Client is in full compliance with this agreement, BJet will operate the Flights for the Client in accordance with, and subject to, the terms and conditions of this agreement in accordance with the attached schedule number, and the Client accepts the attached schedule and its price quote amount. The Flights will be operated by BJet to transport the P passengers in accordance with the provisions of U.S. FAR Part 135 (and any relevant international regulations). BJet Pilots shall be in command of the Aircraft at all times, and shall be entitled to make all decisions regarding the boarding (or refusal to board) any P passengers, and acceptance or rejection of any baggage for Flight.

When the contract is previewed, you can call the specs template to fill-in long-term and short-term items. The long-term items are the Charter-company name, which is a short name that appears in the body of the contract; e-mail address; fax number; Bank wire transfer name, address, telephone, account number, and codes; and State, Province, Country name. Short-term items are the Charter quotation Recipient, Contract person, Number, and Date. For convenience, the contract will automatically include the quoted price from the Bidder screen.


THREE NEW TSA FIELDS ADDED TO THE CREW STATISTICS MODULE - The Crew Stats & Currency screen now includes three new required fields: RVSM expiration, TSA expiration, Emergency expiration. This module already included: Part 297 and 299 expirations, Medical expiration, and Part 293 expirations for first and second aircraft. This screen uses a convenient color-coding

A NEW TWO-PAGE CHARTER CONTRACT HAS BEEN ADDED TO THE NAVPAK COST ESTIMATE - The value of the built-in charter contract is fairly obvious. When it is done from within NAVPAK several items from the bid can be included automatically: a kind of one-stop shopping. If you click on "PREVIEW/PRINT Two-page contract" in the Bid-Preview screen under "Clipboard Options", you can preview a charter contract that can be modified by template to include your specific conditions, names and addresses.

MONTHLY PLANNER FEATURES A NEW YEARLY REPORT BY PURPOSE Sometimes a Part 91 operator wishes to make a report on flights by one or more flight-purposes, such as "Corporate flights" and "Personal flights". Now that can be done easily in the Monthly Planner.

General Information: A filed flight plan is accepted as notification for Private/Corporate flights. All initial arrival and final departure from Bahamas must take place via an airport of entry. All flights at night must be flown under IFR. Night landing or take off at any airport other than MYNN/Nassau requires prior permission. Visas not required. Note: Although Bahamas counts as part of the contiguous territory & Islands under the US visa waiver program, it is very doubtful that you will be allowed back into the US unless you have travelled on an approved Airline. Moreover, if you are allowed back, then the US authorities will take into account the time you spent in the Bahamas as part of your total allowable time. Globally, this must not exceed 90 days. Please check carefully. Still applying a ban on importation of meat products. Coordinates issued by the authorities for use in aeronautical navigation do not conform to WGS-84.

NEW INTERNATIONAL CLEARANCES SECTION IN AIRPORT-AND-FBO SEARCH - The International Clearances feature in Airport Search gives a thumbnail listing of the data necessary for landing in virtually every country in the world, including Mexico, Canada and the United States. This data is updated regularly and provides a great deal of helpful information, such as telephone numbers, time zones and restrictions that are essential for international pilots. The International Clearances can be reached through Other Searches on the Menu Bar of the new Airport and FBO Search module. The data for a desired destination can also be printed. The amount of information varies from country to country. Some countries use a third of a page, while others, such as Canada & the USA require a full page.

EASIER TO CREATE & ACCESS SECONDARY DIRECTORIES IN USER-NAMED TRIPLOGS - When triplogs are saved to a name, the default condition is to save the files to the *Navpak88/Triplogs* folder, which is located on the drive in which NAVPAK is installed. Once 250 trips have been saved in this folder, you will be advised that it would be a good idea to save to an alternative folder. You can create one or a group of alternative folders from the NAVPAK *Startup* screen by putting the cursor on SEARCHES & SETTINGS, then clicking on "Alternate Drives-Folders" and clicking on "Build Directory Groups" in the Menu Bar at the top of the screen. It is also possible to create alternate Navpak folders using Windows' "My Computer" or "Windows Explorer". With alternate folders more current and older triplogs can be archived for later retrieval.

NAVPAK COST ESTIMATES NOW DISPLAY AND ALSO PRINT AN AIRCRAFT PHOTOGRAPH - Cost estimates are generally for trips of eight legs or less. Those trips leave useable space below the itinerary to locate a photograph of the aircraft that will be assigned to the trip. This space can be used for aircraft photographs in color that are cropped to the range of one inch by three inches (1" x 3").

To assist in learning how to use this feature, four sample aircraft photographs are included in the NAVPAK88\BIDACPIX folder. To select an aircraft photograph, select "Clipboard & Printing Options" from the Menu Bar of the Preview-Print screen. Then click on SELECT/SHOW a photograph of the appropriate aircraft in Bid".

You can select one of the sample aircraft that has been provided, or you may include you own photographs. Once you have selected an aircraft, that aircraft will continue to be used until you select another photograph or turn off this feature.
